

Membership Policy

As approved by the Board of Directors on Feb. 16th, 2015

Who Can Be A Member

Subject to the SERN constitution and bylaws, there are no restrictions on who can become a member of the Society, provided that they have been accepted by the Directors.

Membership Fee

A membership fee, if any, will be set from time to time at an Annual General Meeting of the Society. Until such time as a fee has been determined at an AGM, there will be no fee for membership in the society.

Application Process

A person who wishes to become a member of the Society must fill out an application available on the SERN website and send it by mail or email to the Program Coordinator. The coordinator will forward the application to the Directors via email asking that they indicate their acceptance or rejection within 7 days. If there is no opposition to the applicant becoming a member, the coordinator will enter their name in the membership ledger as a member in good standing, and will send them a membership certificate.

If there is opposition to the applicant becoming a member:

- The coordinator will notify the individual that their application will need to be debated by the Directors before being accepted.
- The Directors will decide by majority vote whether the applicant should be accepted.

The Directors may debate the decision and vote by conference call, email, or other form of remote communications.
